Dear Students,

Each year the Finance Committee of the Clark Undergraduate Student Council is entrusted with deliberating over requests for annual budgets by student organizations and issuing recommendations concerning allocations. After clubs have been notified of the initial recommendations students organizations have a right to appeal directly to the Finance Committee or to the entire Student Council at the annual budget meeting. The final budget allocations were approved by the entire Student Council on April 15th, 2009. These budgets will be used to fund their respective student organizations for academic year 2009-2010. The money used to fund annual budgets is derived from the Student Activities Fee (SAF), \$320 fee paid by all students who attend Clark University. The Finance Committee when making its recommendations multiplied the \$320 fee times the number of students currently attending Clark University who will be enrolled next year in addition to a projection of incoming First Years.

In an effort to be more transparent with financial matters and to respond directly to student concerns, the following guide has been compiled detailing a dollar for dollar breakdown as to where funds from your student activities fee have been allocated. All amounts have been rounded to the nearest cent.

This guide contains information about the following types of allocations.

- Monies allocated as a result of a Student Council Bylaw
- Monies allocated as a result of a Referendum, approved by the entire student body in the Spring Elections and April Special Elections.
- Monies allocated to funds administered by the Clark Undergraduate Student Council for programming, student services, and co-sponsorship
- Monies allocated for student organizational budgets.

Please note that there may be some redundancy in listing of allocations on the next few pages, simply because some organizations or funds may fall into two or more categories listed above.

This breakdown should assist students in conceptualizing how their SAF money is being spent and clear up any confusion relating to where the funds have been distributed. For further clarification feel free to contact me at DLeBoeuf@clarku.edu.
